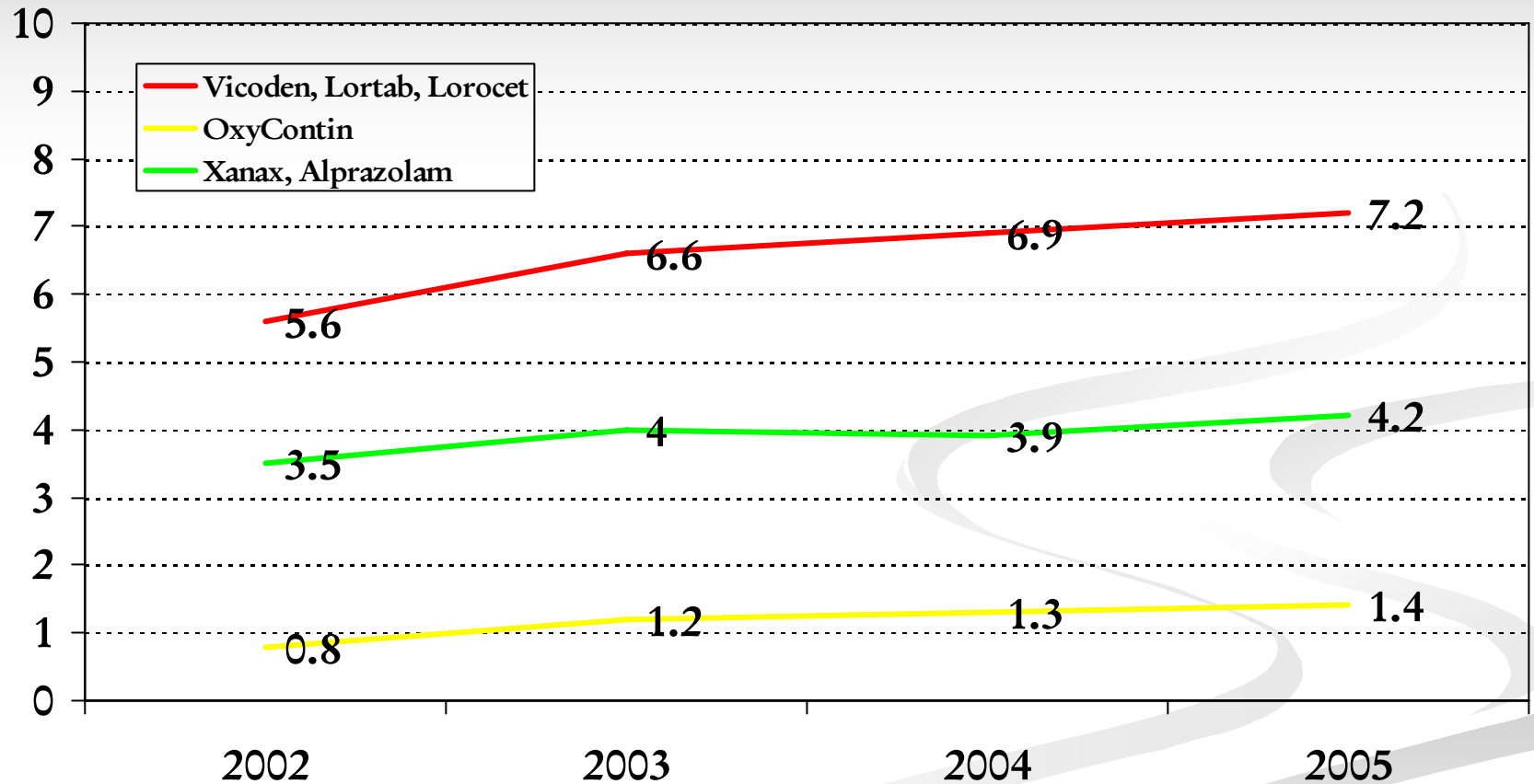

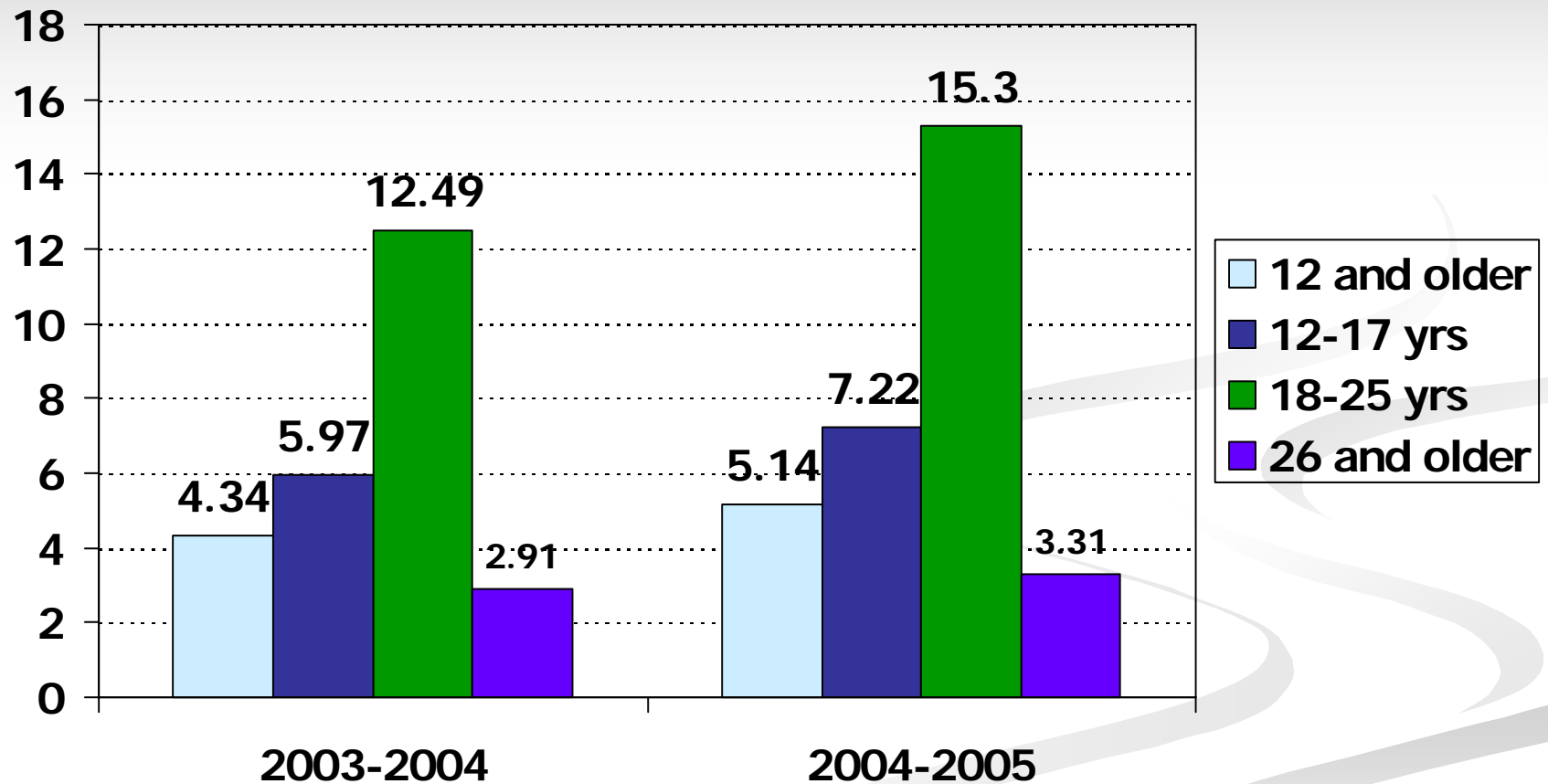

Past Year Non-Medical Pain Reliever Use, Connecticut, 2003-2005

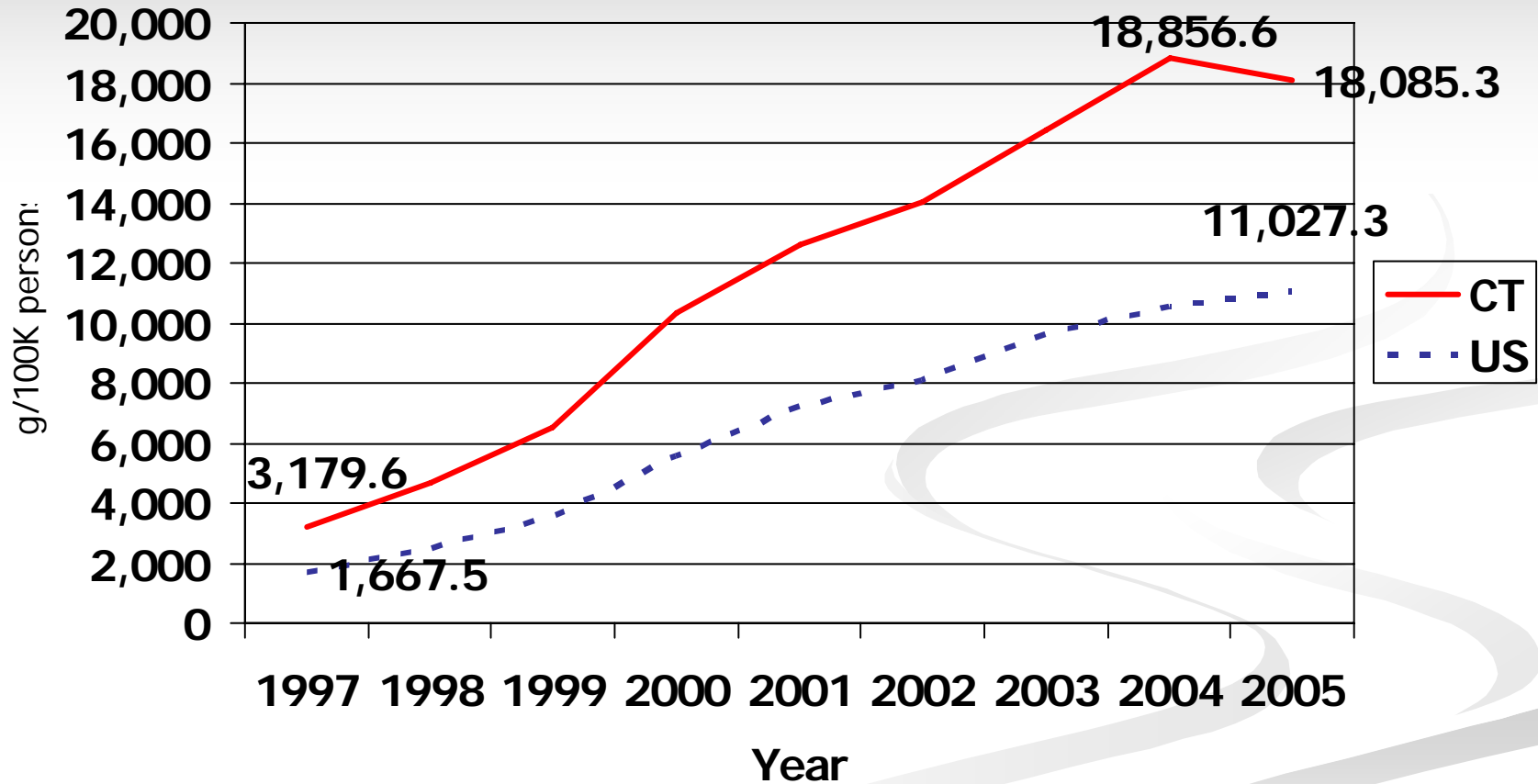

Automation of Reports and Consolidated Orders System (ARCOS)

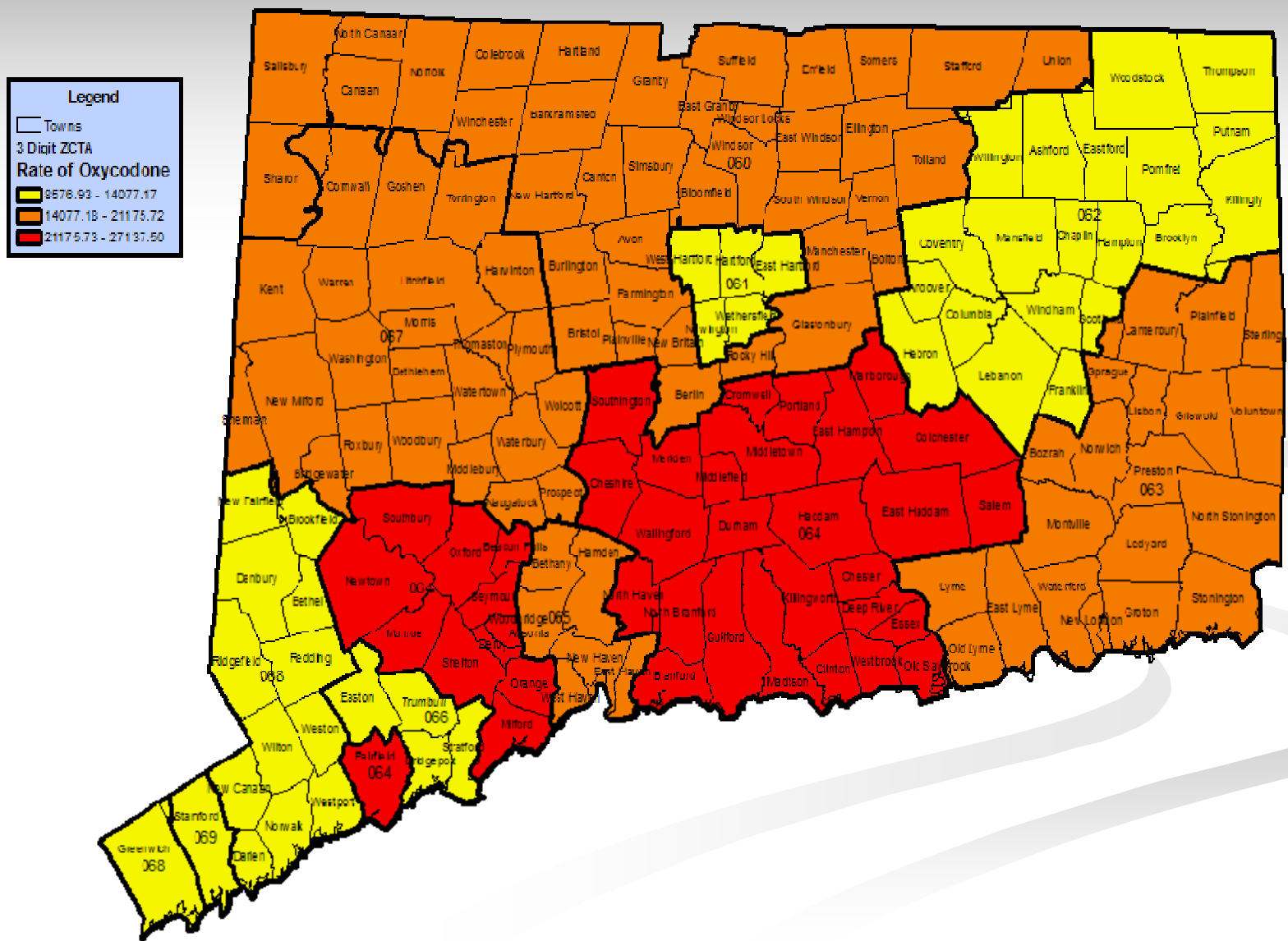
- Controlled Substances Act of 1970 (§ 827) requires Manufacturers and Distributors to report their controlled substances transactions.
- Comprehensive drug reporting system which monitors the flow of DEA controlled substances from their point of manufacture through commercial distribution channels to point of sale or distribution at the dispensing/retail level - hospitals, retail pharmacies, practitioners, mid-level practitioners, and teaching institutions.
- Can use used by Feds and States to identify the diversion of controlled substances into illicit channels of distribution.

Cumulative Distribution of Oxycodone in Grams per 100,000 Population, Connecticut and United States, 1997-2005

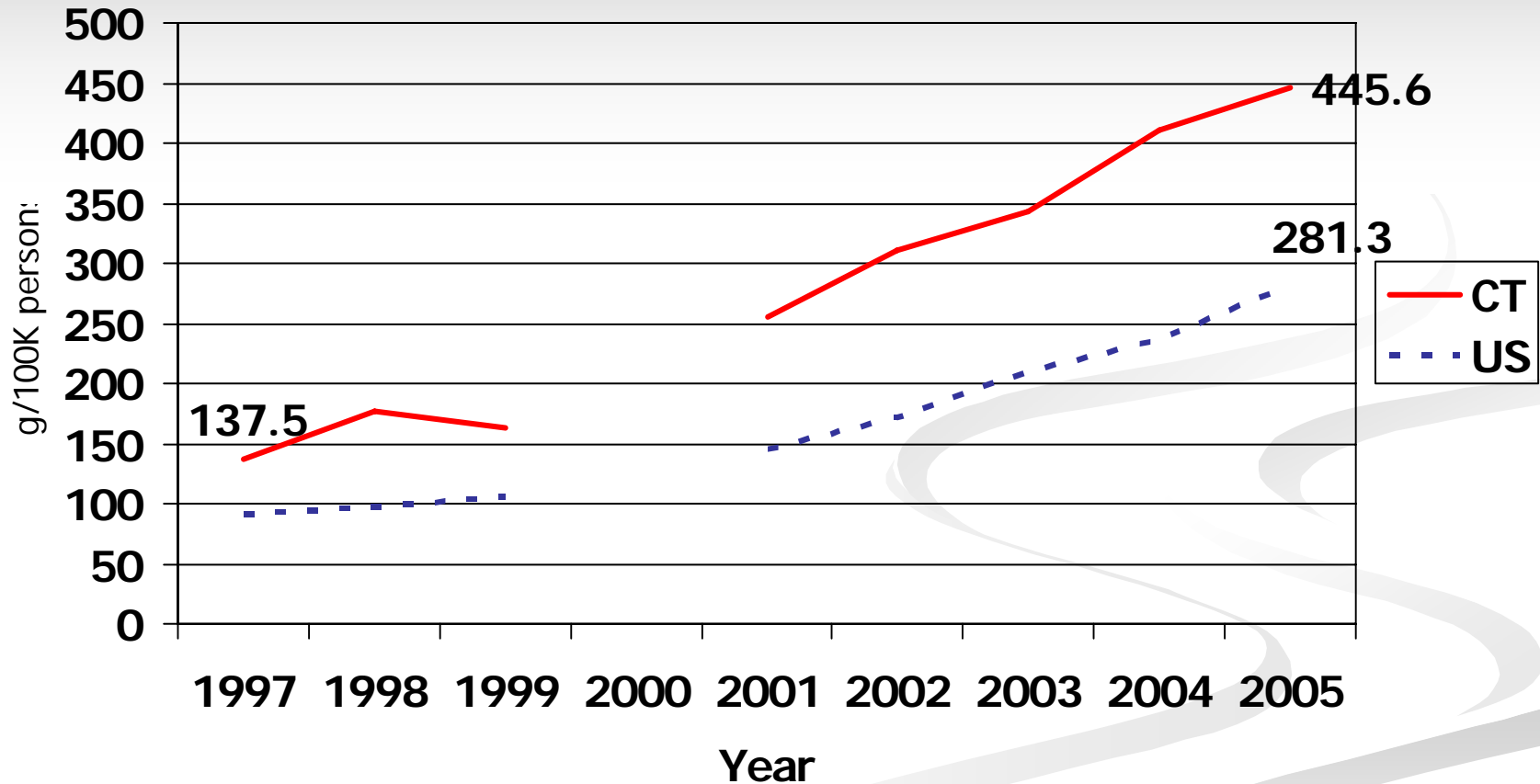

Retail Distribution of Oxycodone in Grams per 100,000 persons by 3 Digit Zip Code Tabulation Area (ZCTA), 2005

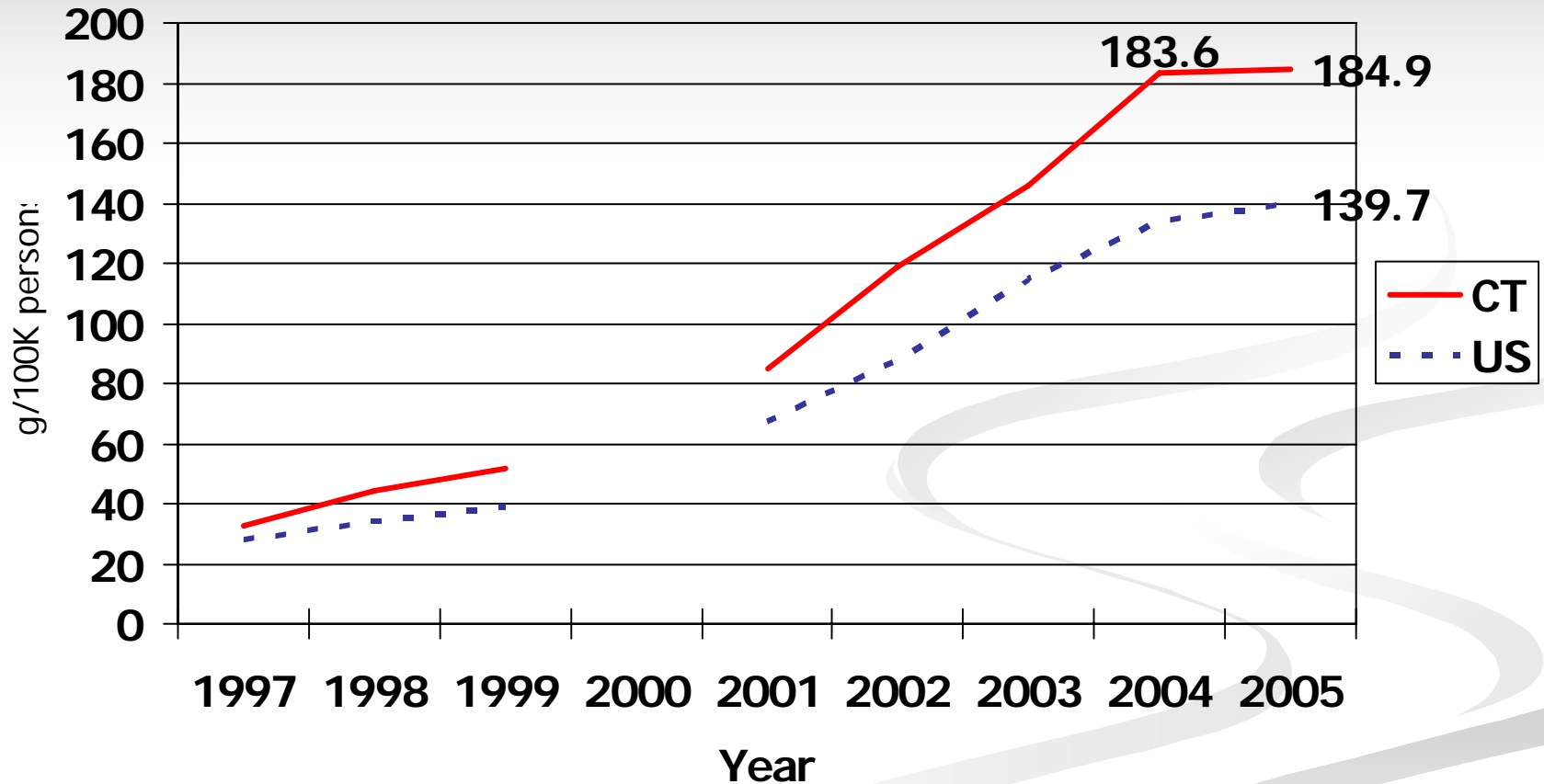


Cumulative Distribution of Hydromorphone (Dilaudid®) in Grams per 100,000 Population, Connecticut and United States, 1997-2005



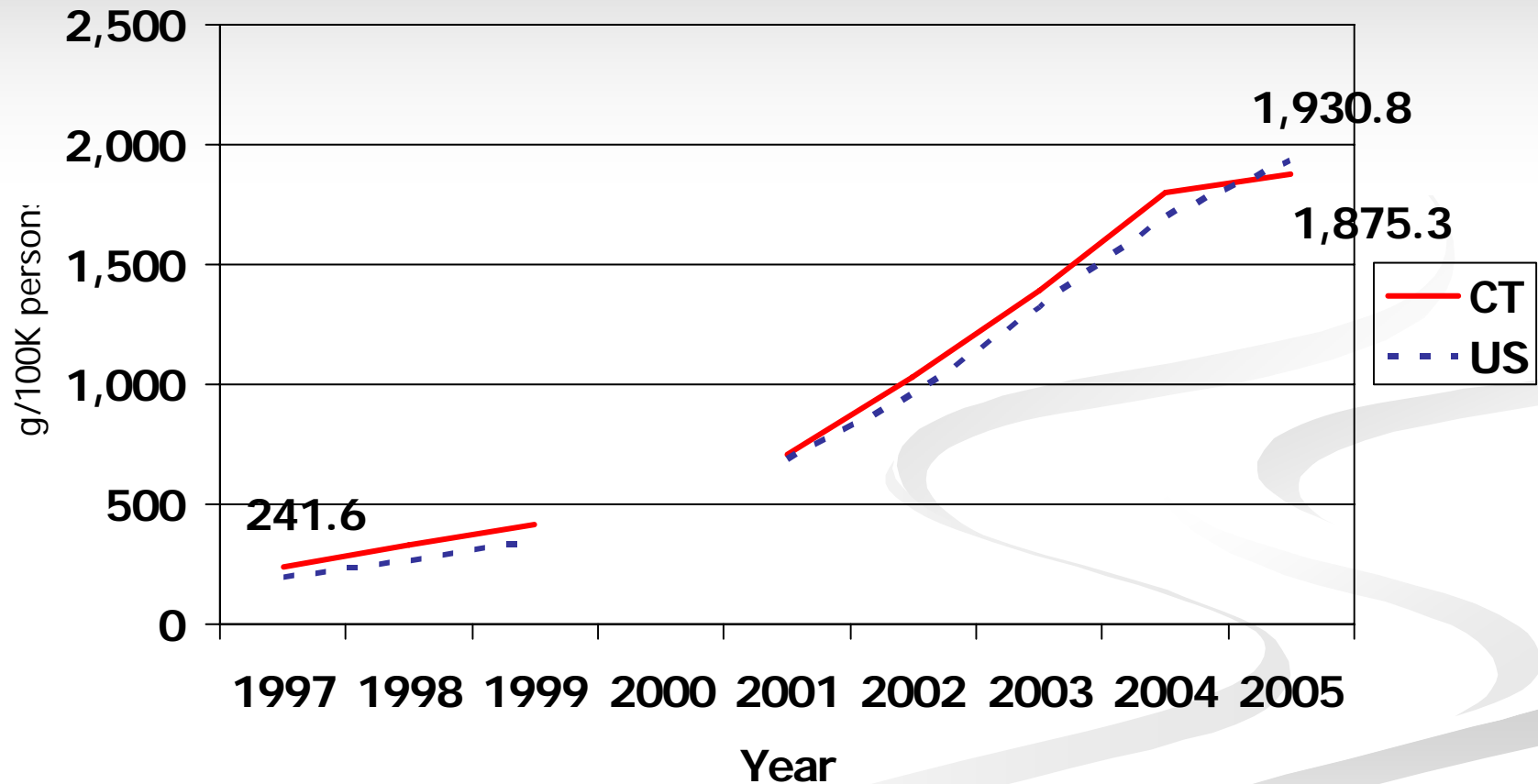

Cumulative Distribution of Fentanyl Base (e.g. Duragesic®) in Grams per 100,000 Population, Connecticut and United States, 1997-2005



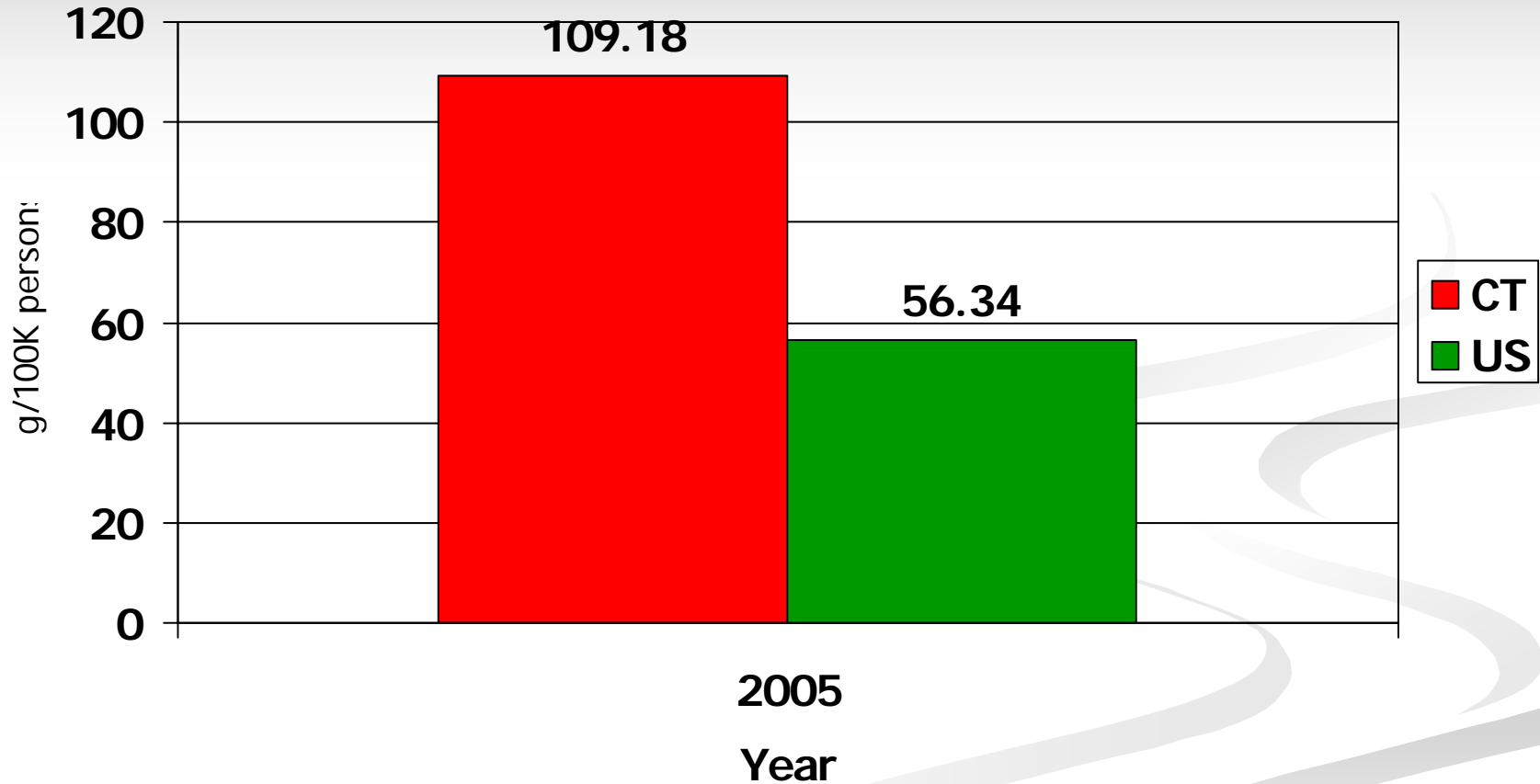

Cumulative Distribution of Methadone in Grams per 100,000 Population, Connecticut and United States, 1997-2005



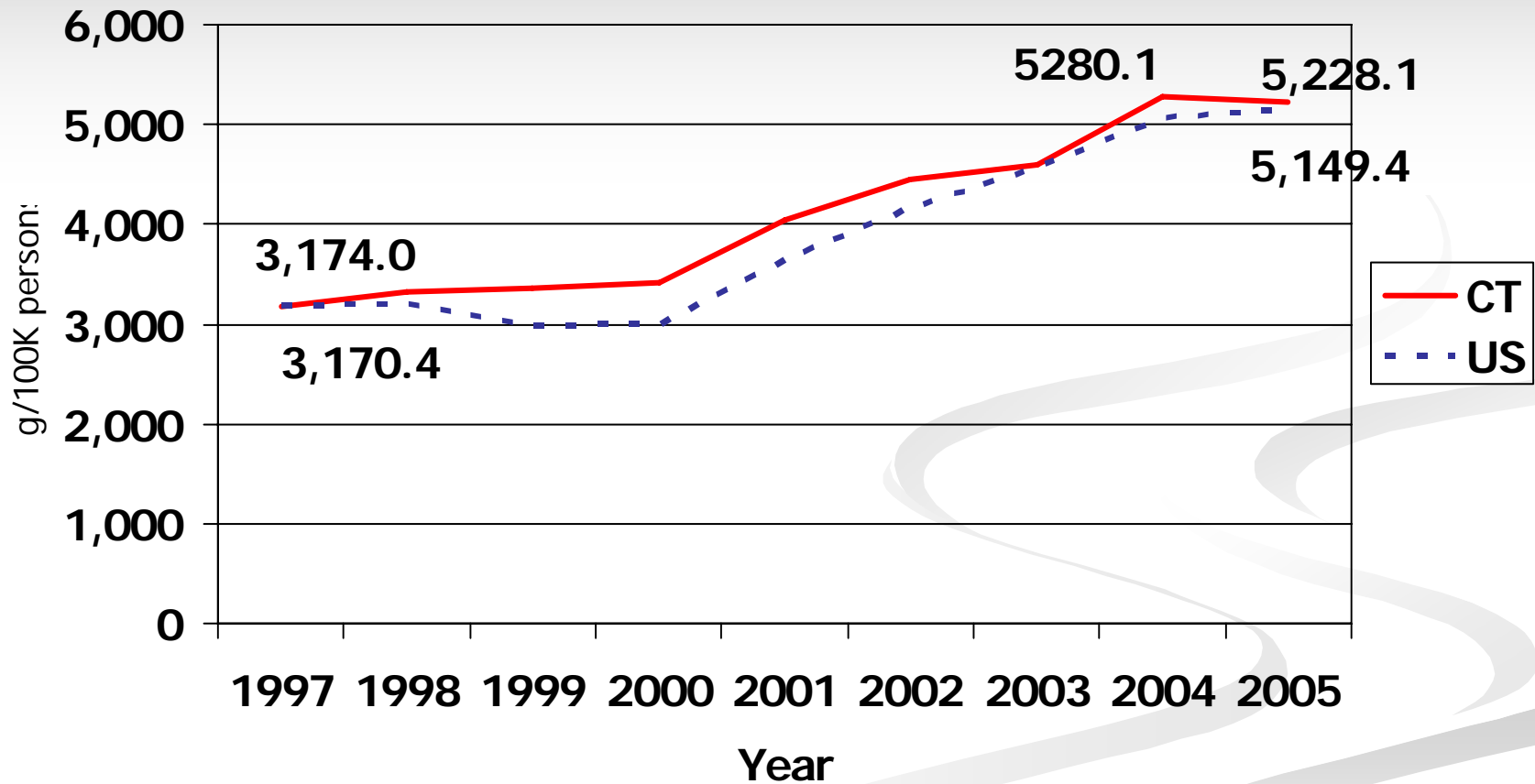
